Eligibility Assessment

To sit the Australasian Veterinary Examination, the initial requirement is a formal assessment of your eligibility to sit the examination.

Assessment may take up to 6 weeks to process.





3. Registration - Letter of professional standing (if applicable)

 Must be registered, licensed or eligible to be recognize as a veterinarian of good standing in the country in which you studied or worked (Letter of professional standing)

Letter of professional standing needs to say

- you are registered to practice as a veterinary by that authority
- You are of good professional standing and good character, and there is no charge of unprofessional conduct or a criminal offense outstanding against you, including where relevant details of any cautions or criminal convictions, as well as absolute and conditional discharges and spent convictions, or any adverse findings, including professional disciplinary proceeding against you
- You hold a veterinary degree

My letter of professional standing was something like this:

"We certify that Dr. Antonella Pannunzio, ID, Professional Registration N° ... is registered in this College of Veterinarians of the Not owing to the date any penalties of suspension or exclusion from enrollment and no mandatory contribution required. Therefore she can practice here as veterinarian without restrictions.

4. English language exam


English language test pathway - you will need to take an English language test to demonstrate that you meet the standard if:

- Your veterinary qualification was not taught and assessed in English
- Your primary and secondary education was not taught and assessed in English in one of the recognized countries.

English language test in the past 3 years:

- IELTS (academic module) with a minimum score of 7 in each of the four components (listening, reading, writing and speaking)
- OET with a minimum score of B or 350 in each of the four components (L, R, W,
 S)
- PTE Academic with a minimum score of 65 in each of the four communicative skills (L, R, W, S)
- TOEFL iBT with a minimum score in each section of the test as follows: 24 for L, 24 for R, 27 for W, 23 for S

My personal experience: I found easier to get the required score with PTE Academic. I paid for a personalized online course which helped me to get the desired score in my first attempt. I studied for the exam for about 2.5/3 months.
